

Large Item Pick Up Guidelines

All materials to be collected should be at the curb **no later than 6:00AM** on your scheduled date. **Do Not** place any container, other than your regular garbage cans, at the curb if you do not want it discarded.

The following items are **NOT ALLOWED**:

- Hazardous materials
- Combustible materials
- Batteries
- Tires
- Liquids
- Railroad ties
- Yard waste
- Regular garbage
- Bulky materials such as drywall, concrete blocks, dirt, rocks, etc.

The following items **WILL BE ALLOWED** if the guidelines are followed:

- Propane tanks – empty, with the valve open
- Gas powered equipment – gas tank must be empty with the lid removed, or the tank completely removed from the equipment.
- Glass larger than 2' x 2', including plate glass windows, must be taped
- Mattresses, box springs, and upholstered furniture must be wrapped in plastic
- Carpeting must be bundled and tied into rolls; not to exceed 4' in length and 2' in diameter. Weight limit equals 50 pounds per bundle
- Appliances, refrigerators, air conditioners, etc., must have the CFC's removed by a certified technician and have the certificate of removal on the appliance.
- Refrigerator/freezer doors must be removed or secured shut.
